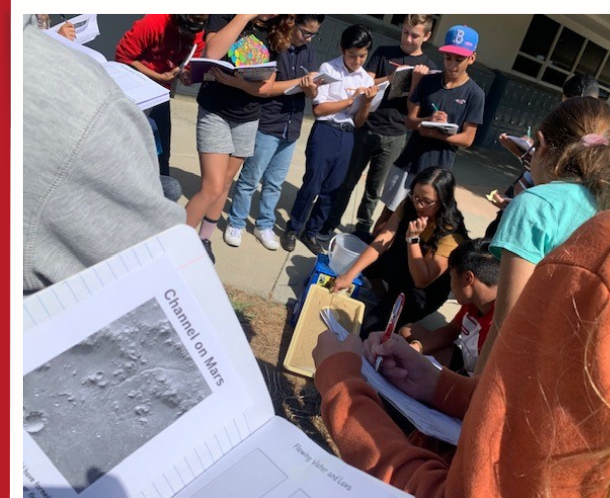

## ABOUT MONTE VISTA

Monte Vista is one of our two comprehensive middle schools in PVSD and is proud to be recognized as a Purple Star School for its dedication to serving military-affiliated students and families. The friendly faculty, staff, and active parent group quickly make all feel a part of the Toro Family. As a comprehensive middle school, Monte Vista students enjoy an extensive amount of opportunities to include: honors courses, Career Technical Education (CTE) pathways aligned to high school and career paths state-of-the-art PE facilities and equipment, a robust intramural sports program, and a plethora of elective choices. Additionally, Monte Vista has WEB, "Where Everyone Belongs" to help all sixth grade, and new seventh and eighth grade students transition to the Monte Vista community. Monte Vista embeds Anchored 4 Life into WEB as a transition service for military-affiliated students.

Monte Vista is known for its successful sports teams. Currently, students have the opportunity to participate in co-ed flag football, boys' and girls' volleyball, boys' and girls' basketball, co-ed cross country, cheerleading, and co-ed soccer. In addition, Monte Vista provides lunchtime student interest groups. These groups are similar to clubs, but they are 100% generated by and ran by students. Students are encouraged to share their interests and create groups hosted by teachers. During lunch, the learning center is open for students to play games which are supervised by our counselors. The Makerspace is open with organized crafts and hands-on projects to encourage students to become involved.

Monte Vista cares about the whole child. A main area of focus is our students' social and emotional well-being. Our counseling offices are located in the Learning Center creating a calm and welcoming environment to engage with our counselors in sessions and groups. Our new Wellness Center is staffed with a part time counselor focusing on social and emotional needs and is open into the evening as a resource for students and families. Our Wellness Peer Elective partners with our Wellness Counselor to teach students self-care strategies.
